COMPETITION RULES

1. Restricted: not having been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a registered Championship since 2004.
2. Protests to be made in writing and received by the organiser within 48 hours of decision accompanied by a fee of \$5. Should the protest be deemed frivolous, the fee will be forfeited.
3. Organiser reserves the right to make alterations or additions.
4. Ages for all sections will be determined on entries received.
5. Competitors may compete in up to 8 dances at this competition.
6. The competition held on Saturday 21st July is a separate competition.
7. Competitors compete at their own risk.
8. Committee reserves the right to give gifts where the word 'trophy' has been used.
9. Premier Sections: Restricted prize will be awarded providing there are three or more restricted dancers and a restricted dancer has not already been placed.
10. "Fill ins" for Reels: If a competitor fails to fill in unless for a medical reason, the organizer has the right to enforce Rule 1f) page 28 D Judges, SOBHD Rules and Regulations, which reads "Provided due prominence is given to the fact in the program or in a brochure by the Organiser, then during the course of a competition the comportment of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only while dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanor likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification, but a full report of any such misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judges to the organisers".
